NUMBERING OF HOUSES AND BUILDING

§4-101. Responsibility for Numbering Buildings.

1. On and after the passage and approval of this Part, it shall be the duty of each and every owner, trustee, lessee, agent and occupant of each and every house, building or other structure in the Borough of Rockledge to cause the same to be numbered in accordance with those plats, maps, deeds or tax records which are in file at the Montgomery County Court Recorder of Deeds and on which show the street address for each and every house, building or other structure.
2. It shall be unlawful to cover any house number with any sign, drapery or other obstruction tending to conceal such number and all old numbers shall be removed from any house, building or other structure when a new number has been assigned, and when so directed by the Rockledge Engineer.
3. The Rockledge Engineer is hereby authorized to require the numbering and re-numbering of any house, building or other structure in accordance with this Part.

§4-102. Penalties.

Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate this Part shall, upon conviction thereof, be sentenced to pay a fine of not more than \$1,000 plus costs and, in default of payment of said fine and costs, to a term of imprisonment not to exceed 30 days. Each day that a violation of this Part continues or each Section of this Part which shall be found to have been violated shall constitute a separate offense.
