

**ROCKLEDGE BOROUGH COUNCIL**  
**COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**  
**OF**  
**July 11, 2016**

The Rockledge Borough Council met at 7:30 p.m. on July 11, 2016 at the Rockledge Borough Hall. After the prayer and Pledge of Allegiance, the roll was called as follows:

In Attendance: Mr. Showmaker, Mr. Praediger, Mr. Corrigan, Mr. Enderle, Ms. Condon, and Mrs. Kehoe..

**Additions to the Agenda:** None

**Adoption of the Agenda:** All were in favor.

**Acceptance of the Minutes:** June 13, 2016 All were in favor.

**Law and Planning:** Mr. Enderle made a motion to accept the monthly building inspector's report. All were in favor.

Mr. Enderle made a motion to adopt Ordinance 653 which prohibits unconnected snow plows from being placed or stored on borough streets, and permitting them when attached only from November 1 through March 30th of each year.

Mr. Goldberg, 146 Park Avenue wanted to know if Ordinance 653 will be effective immediately; Mr. Bresnan state that the ordinance is effective upon adoption.

Mr. Enderle mentioned that there is a Zoning Hearing scheduled for Thursday, July 14 at 7:30 with regards to:

- a variance application received from 205 Huntingdon Pike (Holy Nativity) for the installation of two 8"x16' pre-fabricated storage sheds which do not meet the side yard setback of 20 feet and rear yard setback of 40 feet; and
- a variance application received from 210 Huntingdon Pike for a parking variance; proposed tenant is a Nationwide Insurance Office.

Mr. Corrigan stated that the zoning hearing for 210 Huntingdon Pike is for parking and the Insurance office would be a good business to be there. They would only be using 2 parking spaces opposed to when it was a doctor's office where there was more traffic in and out.

Mr. Bresnan stated that this is on the agenda because council has the option to direct Mr. Bresnan to attend the hearing. Council does not wish to have Mr. Bresnan attend the hearing.

**Finance:** Mr. Showmaker made a motion to accept the monthly bills, previous months' accounts payable check detail report and the Tax Collectors monthly reports. All were in favor.

**Public Service:** Mr. Corrigan advised of the following event:

Paper Shredding Event: Saturday, July 23 from 9:00 to Noon at Abington Junior High School; 2 boxes or paper per vehicle.

**Public Safety:** Ms. Condon made a motion to accept the Police, Fire Marshals, Fire Company June reports, and the Second Alarmer's May report. All were in favor.

Detective Lukashunas was in attendance. He advised that the drug take back box is at the police station and is available 24/7. If you need to speak to a police officer you can call 911 and just say that is a non-emergency and ask for an officer to meet with you at the station. Residents are leaving a message at the station but the officer on duty is on patrol and may not come back into the office for several hours.

Car Show is coming up. Still looking for vendors.

Process has begun for background check on a possible candidate for a part-time officer.

Thank you to the residents who have sent Thank you notes to the station to say thank you for protecting Rockledge.

**Public Works/Property:** Mr. Praediger made a motion to accept the Streets Opening Report and the Streets Department Monthly Report. All were in favor.

Street Department Updates: None.

Mr. Showmaker asked Mr. Praediger about the patching of potholes on Shady Lane. Mr. Praediger advised when we talked last it was for Fox Chase Road, not Shady Lane. Mr. Kyle Dermer was in attendance and stated that some pot holes were filled in with cold patch. To repair correctly a mill machine needs to be rented so that the street can be properly milled.

Mr. Showmaker asked Mr. Praediger about the shed that was budgeted for - Mr. Praediger advised that the shed is in but not installed yet.

Mr. Showmaker asked about the piece of equipment Mr. Micciolo is looking to purchase. Mr. Praediger advised that Mr. Micciolo is still trying to get pricing.

Mr. Praediger made a motion to allow the installation of a bench in Rockledge Park in memory of Mr. Howard Robbins of 200 Shady Lane who recently passed away. All were in favor.

**Recreation:** Mrs. Kehoe advised that summer camp is going well and is being well attended. This year they are taking a trip to the Police Station. Officer Lukashunas will confirm this.

**Personnel:** Ms. Condon had nothing at this time.

Mr. Showmaker asked Officer Lukashunas when the new officer will be sworn in. Detective Lukashunas stated that he is hoping by the August 8th council meeting. He will schedule with the Personnel Committee to conduct the interview. We are not replacing anyone - just putting another officer in our pool.
