Position: Police Detective

Status: Part-Time

The Borough of Rockledge is hiring a Police Detective to work in the Rockledge Police Department under the direct supervision of the Police Chief.

GENERAL INFORMATION

- Part-Time
- Flexible Hours
- Plainclothes (business casual, and business attire when required or instructed by the Police Chief)
- Up to \$35 per hour, depending on experience and qualifications
- Average of 22-27 hours per week or 90-110 hours per month
- Position limited to 29.5 hours per week or 129.5 hours per month, per guidelines established by the IRS in compliance with the Affordable Care Act

GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

- Flexibility to work up to 29.5 hours per week and/or 129.5 hours per month
- Ability to bend, stoop, squat, reach above shoulder level, crouch, kneel, lift, and push and pull for up to 25% of the workday and when required to process crime scenes, when needed to collect, store and transport evidence.

GENERAL QUALIFICATIONS

- Municipal Police Officers Education & Training Commission certification (or re-certified within 90 days)
- Prior police detective, criminal investigator, or patrol investigator
- High school diploma or equivalency required; some college preferred
- Required to undergo an extensive background investigation in accordance with Pennsylvania Act 57, as it amends Pennsylvania Title 44.
