

**COMMITTEE MEETING MINUTES**  
**OF**  
**December 16, 2024**

The Rockledge Borough Council met at 7:00 p.m. on December 16, 2024, at the Rockledge Borough Hall. After the prayer and Pledge of Allegiance, the roll was called as follows:

In Attendance: Mr. Enderle, Mr. Briggman, Mr. Creedon, Mr. Clarke, Mr. Boyle, and Mr. Menniti.

**Acceptance of the Minutes:** Motion to adopt the minutes from November 25, 2024. All were in favor.

**Law and Planning:** Mr. Briggman made a motion to accept the monthly building inspector's report. All were in favor.

**Finance:** Mr. Enderle made a motion to accept the monthly bills, Tax Collector's, previous months check detail report and Treasurer's report. All were in favor.

Mr. Enderle made a motion to adopt Resolution 2024-04. A Resolution of the Borough of Rockledge, County of Montgomery, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania appropriating specific sums estimated per the 2025 Budget to be required for the specific purpose of the municipal government, hereinafter set forth, during the year 2025 by the Borough Council of the Borough of Rockledge, County of Montgomery, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. All were in favor.

Mr. Enderle made a motion to adopt Ordinance 684. An Ordinance in the Borough of Rockledge Montgomery County, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, fixing the tax rate for the year 2025 at 10.60 mills. All were in favor.

Mr. Enderle made a motion to allow the Borough Manager to pay any bills between now and the end of December.

Mr. Enderle made a motion to use the ARPA funds as follows:

- \$130,000 to be used for balance of MS4 Storm Sewer Filter project. All were in favor.
- \$132,000 or remainder of funds for Borough Watch Camera System Project. All were in favor.

**Public Service:** Mr. Creedon advised that the reorganization meeting will be January 6, 2025 at 7:00 pm.

**Public Safety:** Mr. Boyle made a motion to accept the Police and Fire Company reports. All were in favor.

Town Watch: Mr. Fries gave a year end report: They logged 780 miles and 178 man hours. Thank you to Mr. Creedon and Dawn for their involvement.

Mr. Boyle wanted to remind everyone that the Fire Company will have their annual Santa Run on Christmas Eve starting at 5:00 pm. He hopes that the weather is mild.

Chief Horajecyj had nothing at this time.

**Public Works/Property:** Mr. Creedon made a motion to accept the Streets Opening Report and the Streets Department Monthly Report. All were in favor.

Mr. Hess:

- Leaf collection is ending
- There was 22 tons of salt delivered and we have a reserve up at Abington's Public Works yard.
- All the equipment has been tested in case there are any snow storms forecasted.

Mr. Poster wanted to discuss research he did regarding gym rent. Council were all were in favor of changing the fee schedule to reflect gym rent to be \$25.00 per hour.

Mr. Robert Ucci, 305 Montgomery Avenue asked that if there are any problems with Fox Rok using the gym to please contact him or Harry White.

**Parks & Recreation** Mr. Menniti gave the 4<sup>th</sup> of July updates:

- There will be a dine and donate at the Malthouse on Saturday, December 21, 2024 from 12:00 to 4:00 pm.

- Comedy night is on February 22, 2025 at the Firehouse and tickets are on sale now.

Mr. Menniti wanted to talk about the 1<sup>st</sup> annual tree lighting that was here on November 30. It was a little chilly but there was a good turnout, about 200 people. The 4<sup>th</sup> of July Association provided hot chocolate and cookies. There were two singing groups.
